## SCCYAA Standards For Coaches, Players and Parents

To promote responsible behavior and Christian values that create an orderly, nurturing, positive and safe environment for our athletes, all coaches, players and parents/spectators participating in SCCYAA programs will be required to abide by the following rules:

1). Any behavior that can be construed as threatening, abusive, taunting or intended to incite or provoke will not be tolerated. Profanity and/or abusive language also will not be tolerated.

**Minimum Penalty :** Warning from a game official, league officer, school administrator or SCCYAA officer. .

**Maximum Penalty :** Immediate ejection from the game and playing facility; and suspension from the next scheduled and played game. If a second offense is committed, the individual will be suspended or banned from facilities for the remainder of the season.

2). Vandalism of playing equipment and facilities or of vehicles associated with any campus or event participants will not be tolerated.

**Minimum Penalty:** Immediate ejection and/or suspension from the next scheduled and played game.

**Maximum Penalty:** One year suspension from all SCCYAA programs and/or legal charges filed.

3). No one shall at any time lay a hand upon, shove, strike or physically attack in any manner any participant, official or spectator at a SCCYAA-sponsored activity.

**Minimum Penalty :** Immediate ejection and/or suspension from the next scheduled and played game.

**Maximum Penalty:** One year suspension from all SCCYAA programs and/or legal charges filed.

4). No one shall discuss in a confrontational manner any decision reached by an official or staff. Only a coach, league official, team official or SCCYAA representative may discuss the matter with the official or staff.

**Minimum Penalty:** Warning from a game official, league officer, school administrator or SCCYAA officer.

**Maximum Penalty:** Ejection from the present game and suspension from next scheduled game and played game.

5). Use of alcohol in the immediate vicinity of the designated playing facility is prohibited.

**Minimum Penalty:** Warning from a game official, league officer, school administrator or SCCYAA officer.

**Maximum penalty:** Ejection from the game area and/or legal charges filed.

6). Use of or being under the influence of illegal drugs will result in **immediate ejection from the game, dismissal from SCCYAA programs and/or legal charges filed.**

7). All individuals participating in activities on the Skaggs Catholic Center campus will be required to follow all posted signs and rules. This includes, but is not limited to: picking up trash after events; adhering to posted speed limits; parking in permitted parking areas only; and general respect for the facility. Violations of these rules may result in the use of the facilities being suspended or revoked.
